Availability of Flat Screen Computer Monitors



BACKGROUND

Federal Management Regulation (FMR) 102-36.35 states that all executive agencies must, to the maximum extent practicable, fill requirements for personal property by using existing agency property or by obtaining excess property in lieu of new procurements.

INFORMATION

USDA's Centralized Excess Property Operation (CEPO) in Beltsville, Maryland, currently maintains over 900 flat screen computer monitors (17-inch and 19-inch monitors), available for immediate transfer at no cost. According to USDA's Office of the Chief Information Office, the monitors have been tested, adjusted and cleaned. Models include Dell, HP, Hyundai, and Planar.

Acquiring monitors from CEPO will provide direct cost savings, enhance recycling of electronics through continued use, and ensure compliance with Federal Management Regulations. The REE Labor Services will pick-up the monitors from CEPO and deliver them to your office.
