

FEDERAL EXCESS PERSONAL PROPERTY (FEPP)

**DO YOU KNOW WHAT
YOU'RE MISSING?**



If you are asking yourself - What is FEPP and how does it effect my University - Read on!

Last year your colleagues at 1862 Land Grant Universities acquired **\$30 million** in Federal excess property. They acquired traditional/systems furniture, vehicles, heavy equipment, office equipment, lab supplies, tools, etc. **FEPP is a direct savings to the University - it helps stretch annual budgets.**

So Again, What is FEPP?

Regulations require Federal and DOD agencies to report property they no longer need as “excess”. Through partnerships with USDA, Land Grant Universities are eligible to obtain Federal and DOD property reported as excess to directly support research and extension programs.

How much does FEPP cost?

There is no charge for FEPP - except for shipping costs. And certain DOD property is shipped **Free!**

How do I find FEPP?

Finding FEPP is easy! All you need is a computer and let your fingers do the walking. By using the internet, you can view all available excess property nationwide while sitting at your desk.
